

animals? Giardia, Roundworms, Salmonella, E.coli just to name a few common diseases spread by dog feces. 14% of Americans tested positive for roundworms according to a recent CDC study. The longer dog waste stays on the ground, the greater the contamination.

Crandall ISD hosted a soft opening for their newest elementary school, Hollis T. Dietz Elementary, on Monday, August 7, 2017. The Dietz family was present, as well as staff members in the district, CISD Board of Trustees and members of the community.

Dietz Elementary is Crandall ISD's fourth elementary school and will formally open their doors for the 2017-2018 school year on August 22, 2017.

The school is named after Mr. Hollis T. Dietz of the Dietz Cotton Gin, a longtime staple in the city of Crandall. Mr. Dietz was very active in both the city of Crandall, and the Crandall ISD school district for many years. In the school entry, a sign from the original Cotton Gin,

> that was saved from the demolition, is prominently displayed.

Dietz Elementary was built with the funds from the last construction phase of the 2007 Bond Election.


