Pool Hours & Guidelines

Pool hours & guidelines can be found on the community website, www.heartlandtx.net. The pool will be open 10am - 9 pm each day when seasonal hours begin. Please make sure you bring your pool card each time you visit the facility. Here are some tips to make sure you can beat the heat this summer:

- Make sure your account is current with no past due assessments or outstanding fines.
- If you've not had your picture taken or received an amenity card, stop by the Association Office during business hours. No amenity card, no admittance.
- Replacement of lost cards can be purchased for \$10 from the Association Office.
 Please stop by during business hours.

Severe Weather Policy

In the event thunder or lightning is seen at the pool, the pool will be closed for a minimum of thirty minutes, following the last crack of thunder or bolt seen or heard. The reopening of the pool will be decided by the Pool Monitor and the pool will only be reopened when the weather is no longer threatening. Under severe weather conditions, members are requested to clear the pool quickly and follow the instructions of the Pool Monitor. These instructions may include entering the bath-houses or requesting that all members seek shelter in their cars, or leave the facility.

Revised Pool Rule:

Guest Pool Entry—

Four Guests are permitted, per visit, per household, which must include 1 adult over 18 for every 2 children





Hawaiian BBQ Chicken Wrap

Ingredients

- 1 Tbsp olive oil
- 2 boneless, skinless chicken breasts, cut into bite-size pieces
- salt and pepper
- 1/2 cup barbecue sauce
- 1/2 cup shredded mozzarella cheese
- 2/3 cup chopped pineapple, fresh or canned
- 1/4 of a red onion, chopped
- 1 romaine heart, chopped
- 1/4 cup fresh chopped cilantro
- 4-5 large wheat or white tortillas
- Instructions

Heat oil in a large skillet over medium high heat. Add chicken pieces to the pan and season with salt and pepper. Cook, flipping once until chicken is cooked through and golden brown. Remove pan from heat. Add barbecue sauce to the pan and toss chicken to coat.

Place tortilla on a plate. Layer with a spoonful of barbecue chicken, cheese, pineapple, onion, chopped romaine and cilantro. Roll, burrito style and secure with a toothpick. Serve immediately.

Take note on his mowing method ... he mows in a different pattern each week to add depth and contrast of color which makes the yard just more appealing to the eye. He says that the best advice he can give is to NOT overwater your lawn! He doesn't even turn on his sprinkler system until late May/early June. He waters about 5 minutes on all phases, lets the water soak in about 2 hours and then runs the sprinkler system again about 5 minutes more only about 2 times a week! This is really good advice ... Try it on your lawn this year and see if you achieve the same great look!

Tracy has lived in Heartland for about 5 years. She raised her daughters which are both excelling in college. She has always done everything in her yard by herself until a few years ago when she was literally hit by a truck coming around the corner of her cul de sac! She was on the curb of her yard and the truck was obviously out of control. She was unable to walk for about 3 months. As luck would have it, she is now much better and is very delighted to once again tend to her own yard. She credits her grandfather for all of her knowledge and desire to have a nice yard. 

The first Saturday in June of each year is the annual Free Fishing Day and no person is required to have a fishing license or stamp endorsements while fishing on that day.




